CLASSES

Motorcycles/Quads shall be classified as follows:

- CLASS 1: Open Two Wheelers
- CLASS 2: Clubman Two Wheelers(Support)
- CLASS 3: 85cc
- CLASS 4: Quads A (open)
- CLASS 5: Quads Clubman(Support)
- CLASS 6: Quads B (up to 12 year)
- CLASS 7: Women Quads
- CLASS 8: 50cc

Minimum riders per class 3 No. / Organizer have the right to cancel a class should there be not enough entries.

ENTRIES

Entries open immediately and close on 24 June 2006 at the Farm Lichtenstein approximately 35 km south of Windhoek on the Rehoboth road. There will be markers next to the road on that day.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee will be N\$ 150.- / N\$ 75.- for competitors up to 85cc, support & development class.

LICENSES

All participants / competitors must hold a valid NMSF competition license.

Development riders can participate on signed Indemnity and medical form.

DOCUMENTATION

Checking of licenses and general documentation will take place from 07h00am at the Enduro route /

Start will be demarcated / Lichtenstein on Saturday 24 June 2006.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION (SCRUTINEERING)

Technical Control will take place on Saturday 24 June 2006 from 07h00.

All machines as well as riders' clothing and equipment, medic bag will be checked. **Quad bikes must have a Deadman Switch.**

FUEL

Only local pump fuel is permitted. Fuel will NOT be available at the circuit.

Octane boosters are not permitted. The use of methanol is not permitted.

VENUE

Enduro Route / Lichtenstein farm.

Length of Circuit: Route approximately 41 km / run app.

START PROCEDURE

Starting position will be determined by a draw .Numbers will be drawn at dovumentation.

Riders will start one – by – one at 1 minute intervals.

INSURANCE

3rd Party insurance is included in Entry Fee (N\$ 15.-)

RIDING GEAR

Protective clothing must be worn by all competitors.

RIDING NUMBERS

Racing Numbers as allocated to the riders, **must be stated on Entry Form.**

Should 2 Riders/or more, have the same racing number, the organizer will allocate a new number / prefix to the entrant.

POINTS SCORING

Points will be awarded to riders in the event according to the following scale:

20 points - 1 st	10 points - 6 th	5 points - 11 th
17 points - 2 nd	9 points - 7 th	4 points - 12 th
15 points - 3 rd	8 points - 8 th	3 points - 13 th
13 points - 4 th	7 points - 9 th	2 points - 14 th
11 points - 5 th	6 points - 10 th	1 point - 15 th

In the case of a tie, the results will be established as follows:

The winner will be declared to be the rider who has achieved the best time during the first selective sector .
If this is not sufficient to decide between the two, the times of the 2nd, 3rd selective sector, etc. will then be taken into accounts

PRIZES AND AWARDS

The following trophies / medals / diplomas will be awarded:

1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class

PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The prize-giving for the event will commence at 19h00 and will be held at **Jokers Pizzeria and Sports Bar** in Windhoek.
