Course And Venue

The Omaruru Motocross Track is situated about 5km outside of Omaruru on the gravel road that leads to the airfield and golf course. The route to the track is clearly marked. Turn left at the first intersection off of the main street just after the BP service station. Follow this road passed the old swimming pool, turn left again at the intersection and travel over the railway line onto the gravel road that leads to the airfield. Follow that road and a few meters passed the turnoff to the airfield turn right and follow that road all around the golf course to the track. The course is between 1.2 to 1.6km long sand track comprising of whoops, jumps, bends and straights, run in an **anti-clockwise** direction.(SSR 12)

Event And Status

The event will cater for the following categories (SSR 2.1):

National: 50cc Snr, 65cc, 85cc, 125cc, Open Senior, Masters, K.O.T.D.

Non National: Clubmen's, 50cc Jnr, Quads

Only riders from the 85cc, 125cc, open senior and masters classes may participate in the K.O.T.D. The K.O.T.D. is only for riders who have entered in the 125cc, open senior, or master's classes.

Eligibility

The competition is open to all motorcycle riders and quad riders who hold a current valid NMSF, MSA or FIM competition licence for motocross and whose motorcycle or quad complies with the specifications contained in the current NMSF SSR's . Only riders with a NMSF National or International License will be legible for the 2006 Namibia National Championships.

Entry Into The Circuit

All persons must pay the relevant entry fees:

Adults	N\$20.00
Minors (under 14)	N\$10.00

Entries (SSR 16.1)

Entries for all riders close on the race day at the Omaruru Motocross Track. Entries are to be submitted on the official entry form and accompanied by the full entry fee of **N\$150.00** for national classes and **N\$100.00** for non-national classes. Riders who enter in more than one class will need to pay **N\$10.00** for each additional class. The organisers reserve the right to cancel a class should less than three entries be received.

Penalty for late a entry N\$100.00

Documentation And Scruteneering

Documentation will take place in the beer tent. The scruteneering area will be clearly marked somewhere in the pits usually close to the beer tent. Please bring your helmet.

Notice Board

The notice board is situated at the lap scorers.

Riders Briefing

Riders briefing will take place at 08h45 on the start line. All riders must be present at the briefing. Failure to attend will result in a **N\$100.00** fine.

Waiting Zone (SSR10.1)

There is no waiting zone demarkated in Omaruru but riders are reminded that they have to be at the unofficial waiting zone **5 minutes** before the scheduled start time. If you have a problem to be there in time, please report to the Clerk of the Course immediatly.

Starts (SSR 9.1)

The starting order for the first heat race will be based on championship points . The subsequent heats will be based on the finishing positions of the preceding heats.

The start will be carried out in accordance with SSR 10.1 and SSR 10.2

End Of The Race (SSR 11.12)

The waving of the chequered flag will signify the end of the race.

Results

After each heat the results will be posted on the notice board at the lap scorers. These results are not to be removed . Additional copies may be obtained from the lap scoring officials.
