Supplementary Regulations for the 10th and 11th round of the Namibian Motocross Championship and the 3rd & 4th Round of the AMU SAC MX Challenge, to be held at Gallina Motocross Park on the 8th and 15th November 2008.

COURSE AND VENUE:

Gallina Motocross Park is situated 15km out of Windhoek on the Okahandja main road. The way to the track is clearly marked, just follow the pointers. The course is between 1, 5 to 2.0 km long and comprises of sand, jumps, bends and straights, run in a clockwise direction. (SSR 12)

EVENT & STATUS:

The race meeting will cater for the following categories (SSR 2.1):

▪ **NATIONAL & AMU CLASSES:**

Bikes: 50cc Snr, 65cc, 85cc Junior, 85cc Senior, 125cc, Open Senior, K.O.T.D.

Quads: Quad A, Quad B, Quad Ladies

▪ **NON- NATIONAL:**

Bikes: Clubman's, 50cc Jnr, ,

Quads: Quad Clubman's, Quad C, Mini Quads

The **K.O.T.D.** is only for riders who have entered in the 125cc and Open Senior classes. This heat will be raced as combined classes and count as 3rd heat for the 125cc and Open Classes, scored per class.

ELIGIBILITY:

The competition is open to all riders who hold a current valid NMSF/FIM competition license / AMU affiliated FMN national license together with a release from their particular FMN for Motocross and whose motorcycle complies with the specifications contained in the 2008 NMSF SSR`S. Only riders with a NMSF national license will be counted towards the 2008 Namibia National Championships.

ENTRY INTO THE CIRCUIT:

Riders will get two entrance tickets at documentation per event.

All other persons will have to pay the relevant entry fee at the gate. Entry fee will be **N\$ 100,00**.

ENTRIES:

OPTION A: FOR SOUTHERN AFRICAN RIDERS ONLY

Entries open immediately and close on Friday 31 October 2008. Entries are to be submitted on the official entry forms provided and be accompanied by the full entry fee that is applicable. All competitors will have to enter via e-mail or fax. The organizers reserve the right to cancel a category should less than six entries be received. Late entries received after the above mentioned closing dates **may be accepted at the discretion of the organizers until Friday 07 November 2008 and Friday 14 November 2008 upon payment of a late entry fee of N\$300-00.**

OPTION B: OVERSEAS RIDERS ONLY.

Payment for entries for all overseas riders will be on Friday 07 November 2008 for the first and second weekend at Gallina Motocross Park at the documentation office. However all overseas riders will have to enter via e-mail or fax before 31 October 2008. No late entry fee will be charged for overseas riders **only.**

OPTION C: NAMIBIAN RIDERS ONLY

Entries will be on 5 November 2008, Round 1, and 12 November 2008, Round 2, at Jokers from 17h30 till 19h00 for Windhoek riders. The Namibian riders from outside of Windhoek will enter the same as the Southern African riders.

ENTRY FEES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Entries are to be submitted on the official entry form and accompanied by the full entry fee as follows:

1st rider per family - N\$550-00

2nd rider per family – N\$500-00

3rd + rider per family – N\$450-00

Day License N\$ 300 + entry fee

N\$ 200 per rider to all WMCC members as starting money at documentation.

(Transponder Rent is Included in entry fee)

The cost of U\$ 10.00 for the AMU licenses is excluded in the entry fee.

Riders who enter in two classes will need to pay N\$100, 00 for the second class. The organizers reserve the right to cancel a category should less than six entries be received.

For the sake of the AMU SAC, riders may enter 2 classes but can only score towards the AMU SAC classes in one class. The rider must determine which class to be scored towards the AMU SAC and notify the officials of this at documentation.

Penalty for late entry is N\$ 500.00

NO FOREIGN CURRENCY WILL BE ACCEPTED AT DOCUMENTATION. ALL FEES WILL HAVE TO BE PAID IN NAMIBIAN DOLLARS or SOUTH AFRICA RAND ONLY.

Telephonic entries will **not be** accepted. However should the appropriate entry fee not be received by **Friday 31 October 2008, the late entry fee will be applicable** for the competitors at the event, except for overseas riders who may pay their entry fee on Friday 07 November 2008 at Gallina Motocross Park.

PROOF OF DEPOSIT

Every competitor has to fax his/her deposit slip through to the organizers before on or before Friday 31 October 2008. Any deposit slip faxed later than given date, shall attract a late entry fee of N\$300-00.

DOCUMENTATION AND SCUTENEERING :

1st INTERNATIONAL WEEKEND 08 NOVEMBER 2008

Please Note: This event will count towards the 2008 Southern African Challenge and only riders with valid AMU licenses will score towards this challenge.

- **Documentation:** 07 November 2008, 17H00 – 20H00 at Gallina Motocross park.
- **Scuteneering:** 08 November 2008, in the waiting zone. All riders must be at this area 20 Minutes before the starting time of practise session.
- Helmets must be presented at scuteneering

2nd INTERNATIONAL WEEKEND 15 NOVEMBER 2008

Please Note: This event will count towards the 2008 Southern African Challenge and only riders with valid AMU licenses will score towards this challenge.

- **Documentation:** 14 November 2008, 17H00 – 20H00 at Gallina Motocross park.
- **Scuteneering:** 08 November 2008, in the waiting zone. All riders must be at this area 20 Minutes before the starting time of practise session.

NOTICE BOARD:

The notice board is situated at the lap scoring house.

RIDERS BRIEFING:

Riders briefing will take place at 06h50 at the entertainment area. All riders must be present at the briefing. Representatives will not be allowed to stand in on behalf of riders but may accompany the rider to the briefing. Failure to attend the briefing will result in a fine of N\$100-00.

WAITINGZONE

The waiting zone is situated at the entrance to the start gate. Each class that is competing must be in the waiting zone ten (10) minutes before the scheduled start time.

START ORDER:

The starting order for the first heat race will be based on Namibian Championship points (International riders will follow the Namibian riders as per draw done after entries on Friday). All subsequent heats will be based on the finishing position of the preceding heat. The start of each heat will be carried out in accordance with SSR 10.1 & 10.2

END OF THE RACE (SSR 11.12):

The waiving of the chequered flag will signify the end of the race. For a competitor to be classified a finisher, the rider must have completed not less than 60% of the total number of laps run to the next completed lap under its own power and pass the chequered flag.

RESULTS:

After each heat the results will be posted on the notice board at the lap scoring house. These results are not to be removed. Additional copies may be obtained from the lap scoring officials **after the days racing**.

PROTESTS:

Refer to SSR 18

Doping tests may be conducted as per FIM doping code and in the absolute discretion of the race Officials

POINTS SCORING:

Point scoring will be as follows:

1st	20 Points	6Th	10 Points
2nd	17 Points	7th	9 Points
3rd	15 Points	8th	8 Points
4th	13 Points	9th	7 Points
5th	11 Points	and further down 1 point until a minimum of 1 point for every finisher.	

SIGNALLING

An allocated signaling area will be clearly marked. Refer SSR 17

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING:

Refer to SSR 4. All Quads are to wear chest protectors and long sleeved race shirts.

TRACK CLOSURE:

The circuit will be closed to any form of riding / practicing from **6 October 2008**.

RIDING CONDUCT

Refer to SSR 16.2. Any competitor's motorcycle found using the access road (tar road), pits or any other area (bar the jetting strip) for testing or being dangerous will be excluded. The rider is responsible for his family and friends behavior.

ADVERTISING

It is a condition of entry that in addition to the general advertising, competition motorcycles shall display the advertising, if any, as stipulated in the category / class for which the motorcycle is entered.

CHANGE OF MOTORCYCLE:

Where a competitor wishes to change motorcycles between heats he may do so provided:

- a. The Clerk of the Course is advised of this intention at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the next heat.
- b. The motorcycle has been passed by the scruteneers.
- c. The competitor must use the same competition number for all the heats.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

A copy of all foreign riders' insurance has to be attached to your entry form and faxed to the organizers. The original medical insurance has to be presented at documentation. Additional cover is available at N\$550-00 which covers both weekends. This is only valid in the SADC region and does not include evacuation to Europe.

COMPETITORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RACE WITHOUT MEDICAL AID COVERAGE.

CREDIT CARD DEBIT AUTHORISATION DOCUMENT

Every foreign rider will have to complete a Credit Card Authorisation document with his normal documentation. Due to past experience where foreign riders leave Namibia without settling their outstanding medical accounts, the organizers are forced to cover themselves with this ruling.

COMPETITION NUMBERS FOR INTERNATIONAL RIDERS:

All International rides must display their initials on their motorcycles. All three number panels must display the rider's initials. For Example: Tyla Rattray : TR

Your initials will be displayed in the official race program. The riders must display two initials, not just the first name or just the surname. **NOTE:** No duct tape lettering will be allowed. Black initials on white background or white initials on any other colored background are compulsory. **LETTERS WILL NOT BE SUPPLIED BY THE ORGANISERS.**

Sizes of these initials must be: Height: 150mm, Width: 75mm, Stroke: 25mm

Quads must display their numbers on the front and on the back of the quad with a vertical plastic number plate of a safe plastic material.

PRIZE GIVING:

Will take place at Gallina Motocross Park at 20h00. Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall in each/all classes per weekend. All 50ccJnr & 50ccSnr Riders will also receive trophies.

The total points added together of both weekends will be used to determine the overall winners.

Riders riding dual classes must bear in mind that the King of the Dirt is the 3rd heat of the day for the 125cc and Open class but can only count towards one class.

NOTE:

A rider must personally be at prize giving to accept his/her trophy. No show, no Trophy and prize money.

Starting Money

Starting money will only be paid after each race day and will be paid per weekend to the individual. Where a team receives starting money, this will be paid to the team manager after each race day. Starting money will only be paid to International entrants and will be as follows:

N\$1000-00 per weekend after the transponder is given back to the race secretary.

All riders from Namibia, South Africa, Zambia and Zimbabwe competing in the AMU Challenge will receive a travel allowance from the AMU. This allowance will however only be paid to the riders at the end of the AMU MX SAC and be paid to their respective FMNs who in turn will refund the riders.
